A favorite amongst the locals and tourists to Rome, the locally sourced ingredients used in this gelateria make gelato to die for! Contents are all markets, so if you have dietary restrictions, you can choose what is suitable for you! Make sure you try their pistachio flavor, with chunks of pistachio through it you will soon understand why this flavor is a favorite amongst most Italians - just ask them yourself!









VIA DEGLI UFFICI DEL VICARIO, 40 (PANTHEON)

Established in 1900 and still run in the family, this gelateria has earned a positive name for itself over the years, making it a hot spot for tourists when visiting the city. Great gelato and the Pantheon is just round the corner, take it to go and sit on the steps of the fountain and admire the wonders of the ancient world.
